

Jamboree Directors

Jill DiSanti is currently entering her sixth year of coaching overall, and her 3rd year as the assistant of Monmouth University. Prior to joining the Hawks in March of 2007 DiSanti served as the assistant at Quinnipiac University for three seasons. A 2005 graduate of Quinnipiac University, DiSanti helped lead the Bobcats to two Northeast Conference tournament titles (2001, 2003), two NCAA tournament appearances (2001, 2003) and the 2002 NEC regular season title - the first team in conference history to finish the regular season with a perfect mark. In addition DiSanti, was a two time NFHCA regional All-American (2003, 2004) as well as a three-time All-Northeast Selection (2002, 2003, 2004).

Maggie Long is currently in her third year as the assistant field hockey coach at Monmouth University. A 2007 graduate of The College of William and Mary, Long captained her team in 2006 and won the President's Award for excellence in Leadership and Commitment to sport. Selected as the New Jersey College Player of the Year in 2007, she has coached at many different levels, including the U-16 and U-19 club teams for SPIRIT USA, the United States Field Hockey Association's U-16 and Level One tournament coach, and the Colonial Field Hockey Club in Williamsburg, Virginia. In addition, Long currently serves as a coach and site director for the Futures Program.

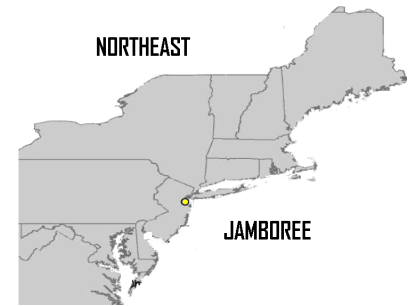
